

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



How many people can your venue accommodate?

With use of the private spaces (30 in Birchwood Room and 16 in The Parlour room). Maximum capacity of the entire loft, lounge & Birchwood Room is 200 seated and 250 standing.

How do I find out about available dates?

What is the rental fee and what is included in that price? Is there a discount for booking an offseason date or Sunday through Friday?

We don't charge rental fees, instead we require minimum food & beverage spend commitments so you receive the most value with your budget. Prices vary seasonally, we also offer discounted rates on Sundays & Weekdays.

How much is the deposit, when is it due, and is it refundable? What's the payment plan for the entire bill?

• Guaranteed guest numbers are required 2 weeks in advance of function. Client agrees to pay for guarantee or actual number of guests, whichever is greater.

• The Parlour will require a \$500 deposit to secure the reservation date. The \$500 deposit is non refundable and is placed on a gift card. In the event of a cancellation, the gift card is given and can be used at any of our CHG properties. The Parlour will require a credit card authorization to be kept on file upon booking.

• The Parlour will require a payment of 33% of the agreed upon minimum food and beverage spend 60 days prior to the event. Another 33% of the agreed upon food and beverage amount is due 30 days prior to the event, with the final remaining bill due at the completion of the event.

• The Parlour will require the full remaining balance to be paid within 24 hours of the event completion.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Can I hold my ceremony here, too? Is there an additional charge? Is the ceremony site close to the reception site? Is there a bride's changing area? How much time is allocated for the rehearsal?

We certainly can accommodate ceremonies.

We do charge an additional \$600.00 for ceremony to account for additional labour.

We can do indoor or outdoor ceremonies (weather pending).

Rehearsal time is flexible depending on the needs of the client.

Is this site handicap accessible?

The main floor of our building is handicap accessible (we have a handicap washroom on the main level) however we do have an upper loft space with no elevator access.

When is the shut down time for the space? Is there a fee I can pay if we stay later?

Last call is typically between midnight and 1 am, and can be discussed to best fit your needs.

Are their decoration guidelines / restrictions? Can I use candles?

No damage done to the walls/fixtures. Candles subject to house guideline, however electric candles are preferred.

Are we able to pay you to set up our decorations or do we handle that ourselves?

Typically the client will handle all décor set-up and tear down. Additional fees will apply if you would like us to handle this.





What is the price per person for an open bar, and are you able to do a cash / toonie bar?

The average cost for a loz drink varies based on menu price, and parameters can be set around the price point of bar offerings. Drink tickets are recommended in place of a cash bar.

Toonie bars and other subsidized bars are done with drink tickets, please ask our team for full options on how to best suit your needs.

Can the venue accommodate either a DJ or live band?

We can easily accommodate a DJ. We can accommodate a live band depending on room lay-out.

How much parking is on site? Is there additional parking/street parking available?

We have 20+ free stalls in our main lot, however we are surrounded by Impark lots that you are welcome to use. (NO PARKING IN DENNY'S LOT – your vehicle may be towed).

How many restrooms are there?

1 handicap accessible washroom on main floor, 2 washrooms on the upper level.

Can I hire my own vendors? [Caterer, coordinator, DJ etc] or must I select form a preferred vendor list?

You are welcome to outsource your DJ, wedding coordinator, florist etc. We do not allow outside caterers.

Do you have a list of preferred vendors?

Please ask your Parlour Wedding Coordinator for an up-to-date list of our preferred vendors.

Is their a coat check service?

We can supply coat check service for an additional charge.

Is there an outdoor space in the summer for guests to mingle/have drinks?

We have a beautiful outdoor patio that can accommodate up to 60 guests seated or 120 standing.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Are tables, linens, chairs, plates, utensils, and glasses provided? Is there a charge or is it included in the rental price?

We supply our own standard items, if you would like to order specialty items you may do so at your own expense.

How does the food options work? Is there a buffet option? Family Style? Plated?

We will only offer Family Style Dining and are happy to make customizations upon discussion with the event coordinator. Dietary restrictions are easy to accommodate with sufficient notice.

Can we do a food tasting before selecting our menu?

Yes, we require I weeks notice for the tasting. Select the menu items you wish to try and our culinary team will put together the tasting menu to present to you and however many guests you choose to bring. The cost of this tasting varies and may be paid at the time of the tasting or added to the final wedding bill if deposit has been paid.

Do you provide a late night snack? If so, what are the options? Can we bring in our own [i.e. Mcdonalds cheeseburgers]

We can do midnight snack easily, typically guests will choose to use the pizza selection from their family style menu and have that served at a later time as the midnight snack. We will not allow outside food to be brought in (Outside of Wedding Cake or Specialty Dessert).

Can I bring in a cake from an outside baker?

Of course, an outside dessert fee of \$2.00/person is charged if you would like us to cut and serve your cake.


Can I bring my own wine, beer, champagne and just pay a corkage fee?


We do not allow outside beverages.
